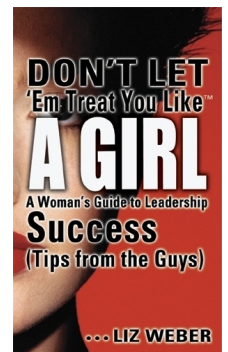
Program Description:
